Course Concept:

Surveys and Research have become part of all endeavors today, be it Corporate, Academic institutions, or Development Organizations. NGOs are involved in baseline surveys, corporations in market and product research, and Educational institutions with scholastic or community research. We need to be more professional with data collection, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of findings. Both qualitative and quantitative analyses are much simplified today through computerized tools and we need to be familiar with them, to help researchers to have a scientific approach to social research and surveys.

At the end of the workshop the participants will learn:

- Techniques of Data Collection.
- Statistical Analysis of Data using SPSS.
- Interpretation and Presentation of Data.
- Report Writing Skills.

Methodology:

The 3-day workshop will use practical exercises, and hands on training besides theoretical inputs to enhance individual learning.
